

“Suning Hong Kong x Prime Visa Shopping Privileges” Terms and Conditions:

1. “Suning Hong Kong x Prime Visa Shopping Privileges” (“Promotion”) is only applicable to cardholders with valid Prime Visa Credit Card (“Eligible Credit Card”) issued by PrimeCredit Limited (“PCL”) in Hong Kong (“Cardholders”).
2. Promotion period of the Promotion is from 1st July 2019 to 31st August 2019 (both dates inclusive) (“Promotion Period”).
3. During the Promotion Period, Cardholders are entitled to HK\$60 cash rebate upon a single transaction of HK\$1,000 – HK\$2,999, HK\$200 cash rebate upon a single transaction of HK\$3,000 – HK\$4,999 or HK\$600 cash rebate upon a single transaction of HK\$5,000 or above with any of their Eligible Credit Card at any Suning Hong Kong stores or online store <https://www.hksuning.com/>. Each cardholder can be entitled up to a maximum amount of HK\$600 cash rebate per day within the Promotion Period and up to a maximum amount of HK\$1,000 cash rebate for the whole Promotion Period. (“Offer 1”)
4. During the Promotion Period, Cardholders can enjoy up to 40% off for purchase of selected items in Suning Hong Kong stores with Eligible Credit Card. (“Offer 2”)
5. The cash rebate that Cardholders are entitled to in Offer 1 will be credited to the relevant Eligible Credit Card accounts on or before 30th November 2019. Upon rebating the cash rebate, the Eligible Credit Card accounts must be valid and in good financial standing. The cash rebate is non-transferable, non-exchangeable, non-refundable and cannot be exchange for cash.
6. All transactions relevant for the cash rebate entitlement in Offer 1 (“Eligible Spending”) must be made during Promotion Period and be posted on or before 7th September 2019. ◦
7. Eligible Spending refers to the retail purchase made with Eligible Credit Card at Suning during the Promotion Period, excludes the following categories of transactions: transactions of purchasing Suning cash voucher, split transaction, transactions via electronic wallets except Union Pay mobile application and Apple Pay , unposted/cancelled/refunded/returned/counterfeit transaction, all unauthorized transaction and any other categories of transactions as PCL and Suning may specify from time to time.
8. Cardholders are required to keep the relevant original credit card sales slips or official payment records of all Eligible Spending. In case of any disputes, PCL reserves the right to request Cardholders to present the relevant original credit card sales slips and/or other supporting documents or proofs of the Eligible Spending for further verification.
9. All returned or cancelled Eligible Spending will not entitle to relevant cash rebate in Offer 1. PCL reserves the right to debit the relevant cash rebate from the credit card account for any returned or cancelled Eligible Spending after the relevant cash rebate has been given without prior notice.
10. PCL and Suning reserve the right to cancel the Promotion and/or amend the relevant terms and conditions at any time without prior notice. In the event of any disputes, the decision of PCL and Suning reserve the right of final decision.
11. Cardholders understand and accept that all products, complimentary gifts and/or services are not provided by PCL. PCL accepts no responsibility whatsoever in connection with such products, complimentary gifts and/or services. All liabilities for any matters relating to the products, complimentary gifts and/or services (including but without limitation to their quality and supply) are solely borne by Suning.
12. No person other than the Cardholders and PCL will have any rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Ordinance (Cap. 623, the Laws of Hong Kong) to enforce or to enjoy the benefit of any term under these terms and conditions.
